




### Overall, how would you rate this teaching assistant?






### Overall, how would you rate this teaching assistant?

Comments
Class is very boring
As much as students hate it, I find calling on random students can help improve the learning experience for everyone in the class.
Grading was scattered and hard to follow her notes, she could help by explaining what criteria was required better.
Kele could slow down her teaching a bit and give more structure to the agenda of the class.
I don't know.
Give better feedback on essays. I have no idea what went wrong in the first essay or how to improve upon it for the second. Additionally, a lot of questions don't get directly answered, or at least the answer isn't super clear.
She honestly was great.
Increasing variety in the presentation of materials
N/A
Maybe more adamantly promote discussion among the students
I would recommend spending more time on going over previously graded assignments, and give more feedback to students about what should have been done better. I would have also liked to see more review for the exams as they are a very large part of our overall grades, but were barely talked about in the course
Towards the end, a lot of the material concerning our final papers became confusing and I wish she would have slowed down in explaining some of the concepts again rather than answering all questions on more of a surface level.
Be more basic in answering questions - sometimes the terms used are ones that I don't necessarily understand
It would be more helpful if she was more available. Also, I feel like she is very vague with grading criteria when it comes to the papers.
Time management
Relate more of the discussion sections to prepare for exams
